The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking bail in case FIR No.279 dated 14.11.2015 registered under Sections 376 and 506 IPC at Police Station Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the prosecutrix has not supported the case of the prosecution to the extent that petitioner/accused had taken the photographs of the prosecutrix while she was taking bath. The petitioner is in custody since 14.09.2016. The prosecutrix has been examined.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the bail application.

Heard.

Considering the fact that the challan stands already presented, the petitioner is in custody since 14.09.2016, out of 07 prosecution witnesses, 04 have been examined including the prosecutrix so, without commenting on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of trial, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/duty Magistrate concerned.
