Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.58 dated 12.03.2015, under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Shimlapuri, District Ludhiana.

As per prosecution version, an alleged recovery effected from the petitioner was of 110 grams of contraband.

As per report of the Chemical Examiner, the same was found to be containing Alprazolam salt.

The recovery as such effected from the petitioner would be construed as marginally over and above the commercial quantity.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Harmesh Lal, Police Station Shimlapuri, Ludhiana apprises the Court that the trial is still at the initial stage as after framing of charges prosecution evidence till date has not been led.

It has gone uncontroverted that petitioner is not involved in any

other proceedings under the NDPS Act.

In view of the above and without making any observations on merits, prayer is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Ludhiana.
