**RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)**

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. has been made for grant of regular bail to petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.595 dated 28.07.2017 registered under Sections 306 and 34 IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, Hisar, District Hisar.

According to the prosecution, one Ravi, real brother of the complainant Vikram committed suicide in the intervening night of 27/28.07.2017 on account of constant threats of the petitioner leaving a suicide note mentioning that the petitioner was responsible for his suicidal death.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner is behind bars since 28.07.2017 and charges are yet to be framed against the petitioner. There is no direct evidence against the petitioner that he ever abetted Ravi to commit suicide. The conclusion of trial will take a long time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in

On the other hand, the learned State counsel, vehemently opposed prayer for grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

Considering over-all facts and circumstances, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Consequently, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds, to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
