INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Gurpreet Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.60 dated 10.07.2016, registered at Police Station Mehna, District Moga, under Sections 379-B and 384 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. The name of petitioner has been disclosed by co-accused, Jaswinder Singh in his disclosure statement. As per the allegations of

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the prosecution, vehicle was snatched by the Manager etc. of the Finance Company due to default in payment.

The petitioner has been in custody since 05.10.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
