1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?
2. To be referred to the Reporter or not.

KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The prayer of the petitioner is that her son Pawan Kumar, aged about 35 years had suddenly disappeared. Therefore, a criminal case should be registered and matter be investigated.

The reply of the State shows that regarding disappearance, DDR No.6, dated 01.05.2015 was registered and thereafter FIR No.29, dated 07.03.2016, under Sections 365, 120-B IPC at Police Station Meharban, Ludhiana was registered against unknown persons on the complaint of respondent No.4.

It also comes out that during the investigation, respondent No.4 wife of said Pawan Kumar has been interrogated. It also comes out that an application for narco analysis test of Geeta Devi, respondent No.4 is pending before the Magistrate since 07.06.2017.

In this way, it comes out that the prayer of the petitioner made in the present petition has been met. The case has been registered and the

investigation is going on. Therefore, this Court cannot interfere nor monitor the investigation.

In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the Illaqa Magistrate to decide the application for narco analysis test of respondent No.4-Geeta expeditiously and not later than 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. The police is directed to carry out the investigation expeditiously and submit the final report to the court concerned. However, in case the petitioner is not satisfied with the investigation, she can always approach this Court.
