On 13.07.2016, both the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate for recording their statements in the context of compromise. They could not appear before the Illaqa Magistrate within stipulated period and thereafter, petitioners filed criminal miscellaneous No. 3253 of 2017 for granting one more opportunity to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate.

Vide order dated 07.02.2017, parties were again directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate on 20.02.2017, for recording their statements in respect of genuineness of the compromise in question.

As per report received from the Illaqa Magistrate, parties have not appeared before the Court, it appears that parties are not interested in pursuing this case anymore.
