The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 160 dated 08.08.2017, under Sections 398, 401 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sanoli, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR, which has been registered on the basis of secret information, are that the petitioner along with three others was trying to rob various persons, who were passing by. He further contends that neither any person is stated to have actually been robbed nor any individual complainant has come forward in this regard and only a torch has been recovered from the petitioner. He also contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case and is in custody for over 04 months since his arrest on 08.08.2017.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Sri

Bhagwan states that the investigation has been completed and the challan has been filed in Court.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 04 months and the investigation has been completed, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner, namely, Rakesh is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
