The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.818 dated 30th October, 2016, registered under Sections 328/379/420/34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits *inter alia* that the petitioner has remained in detention for more than 09 months.

In the meantime, virtually all the private witnesses including the complainant have been examined by the Ld. Trial Court. The statements of the witnesses including that of the complainant (Anneuxres P-3 and P-4) do not reveal any tangible material against the petitioner.

In the circumstances, petitioner's further indefinite detention at this stage is not justified. He may, therefore, be released on an interim bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court which shall be at liberty to cancel the same in the event of any incriminating material coming forth against the present petitioner subsequently during trial.
