Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.152 dated 07.10.2016 under Sections 457, 380 IPC (Section 201 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is aged about 19 years and he has been named by co-accused Karamjit Singh. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that even as per the disclosure statement of Karamjit Singh, he was the person who was having knowledge about the house of the complainant and the petitioner has been arrested on 15.10.2017, after about 01 year of registration of the FIR. It is further submitted that recovery from the petitioner is of 03 coins of silver and the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, has referred to the disclosure statement of co-accused Karamjit Singh, from which it is apparent that he masterminded the commission of alleged theft.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
