The learned counsel for petitioner contends that petitioner had purchased some land, regarding which civil suits are pending. Now, respondent No. 5, who happens to be Deputy Superintendent of Police, Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar, is calling him time and again to the police station to compel him to pay more money to private respondents No. 7 to 10.

In these circumstances, without issuing notice to State, present petition is disposed of with a direction to official respondents that petitioner will not be called to police station without issuing notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C., specifying the date, time and reason, for which he is being summoned to police station.
