Present petition is for release of petitioner on regular bail in FIR No.13 dated 02.10.2015, under Sections 376(2)(n), 376(D), 363, 366, 506 IPC and Section 4 of POCSO Act), registered at Police Station Women Hisar, District Hisar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the investigating officer, has informed that in the present case the prosecutrix and her father have since been examined and there are total 35 witnesses, who are yet to be examined.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and with their able assistance gone through the material available on record.

The petitioner was arrested on 15.10.2015. Since then, he is in judicial custody and no useful purpose would be served to further detain

him in jail. The final conclusion of trial will take a long time.

In view of above facts, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Judge/Duty Magistrate, Hisar.

Needless to mention that, nothing observed here-in-above, would reflect, on merits in the trial of the main case, in any manner.
