The present petition has been filed seeking transfer of proceedings pertaining to FIR No.1106 dated 05.12.2016, registered at Police Station Hissar City, District Hissar for offence punishable under Sections 323, 354(A)(1), 406, 498-A, 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 from the competent Court at Hissar to an appropriate Court of Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhari.

After arguing for some time when the Court did not appear to be accepting submissions made in the petition, counsel for the petitioner states that he confines his prayer only to the extent that as the petitioner has to appear as a witness for the prosecution being the complainant, the trial Court at Hissar may be directed to record her testimony as a witness on the date she is called for the purpose and actually appears before the said Court.

Keeping in view the limited prayer made by counsel for the petitioner, the petition stands disposed of with a direction to the trial Court at Hissar that the day the petitioner causes appearance for her testimony in pursuance of summons issued by the trial Magistrate, the Court would ensure that her examination in chief and cross examination is completed on the same day. However, the petitioner shall appear before the Court at Hissar on the stipulated date at 10 AM sharp.
