Vide this order, the above mentioned two petitions would be disposed of as the petitioners in FIR No.340 dated 08.09.2014, under Sections 420-120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar, Panipat, the petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

These two petitions gave rise to the mediation case No.1149 of 2015. Now, there is a report dated 18.01.2017 from the Deputy Registrar for Director, Mediation and Conciliation Centre, enclosing the documents from Pages No.1 to 32 and the report of the mediator-Mr. Atul Nehra that the settlement between the parties in

respect of their dispute has been arrived at. Accordingly, the settlement agreement has been executed and signed by the respective parties. The documents of mediation as well as documents executed, are on record.

In view of the settlement arrived at mediation, the dispute between the parties appears to have come to an end, and therefore, all these proceedings are liable to be disposed of in terms of the settlement and agreement drawn before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. In the result, following order is made:-

ORDER

- (i) CRM-M-7142 of 2015 is disposed of making the interim order dated 04.03.2015 absolute;
- (ii) CRM-M-8315 of 2015 is disposed of.
