ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.39 dated 11.04.2017 under Sections 302/148/149/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Makhu, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that she along with others, had given beatings to the deceased with daang and sticks. Even as per FIR, the petitioner was unarmed and after investigation, she has been found innocent and challan has been presented against four other accused. He also contends that the petitioner has given birth to a child today itself and has been in custody for over seven months.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh, states that the petitioner has indeed been found innocent during investigation and challan has not been filed against her. He has also filed custody certificate today in Court which is taken on record.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the fact that she has been found innocent during investigation and is in custody for over seven months, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner Komalpreet Kaur @ Kamaljeet Kaur is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
