The petitioners are seeking a direction to official respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty as they are apprehending danger from the private respondents.

Reply on behalf of official respondents No. 1 to 3 has been filed in the form of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Tarn Taran, wherein, it is stated that petitioners No. 1 and 2 had married against the wishes of their relatives. Their statements have been recorded on 15.06.2017, wherein, they have stated that they do not require any police protection/security as they do not have any threat. Copies of the statements of petitioners No. 1 and 2 have been appended with the reply as Annexures R-1 and R-2 respectively. The statement of respondent No. 4, who is the father of petitioner No. 1, has also been recorded, wherein, he has stated that his daughter (petitioner No. 1) has performed marriage with petitioner No. 2 on

16.04.2016 and he and his family had not harassed the petitioners No. 1 and 2 earlier and will not do so in future as well.

In view of the above, no further directions are called for in the petition, which stands disposed of.
