The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.293 dated 04.10.2017, under Sections 354, 354-A, 379, 356, 511, 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Industrial Area, Phase-1, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner herein was taken into custody in the aforesaid FIR on 04.10.2017. It is submitted that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case. It is argued that in fact, the matter has been compromised between the parties and a petition for quashing of the instant FIR has already been preferred bearing CRM-M-39800 of 2017. It is also contended that co-accused Raj Kumar has already been granted regular bail by this court in CRM-M-45816

of 2017, therefore, the petitioner is entitled to be enlarged on bail.

Per contra, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State, on instructions from ASI Davinder Singh, PS Industrial Area, Chandigarh, opposes the grant of regular bail.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since, the trial is likely to take some time and in view of the facts that the matter stands compromised between the parties and co-accused has already been granted bail, no useful purpose would be served in keeping the petitioner behind bars. At this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
