The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.176 dated 13.08.2017, under Section 306 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Canal Colony, District Bathinda.

Upon instructions from the police official, learned counsel for the State submits that there is no other case is pending against the petitioners and the investigation has been completed.

Looking to the nature of offence and fact that the trial will take its own time, the petitioners be released on bail, subject to the following conditions:-

(i) The **CRM-M-47388 of 2017** is allowed.

(ii) The petitioners be released on bail to the

satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.

(iii) The petitioners to surrender their passport with the trial Court, if they possesses the same.

(iv) The petitioners would file an undertaking to the trial Court that they will not commit the same or any other kind of offence in future.

(v) Petitioners shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.

(vi) In case, the petitioners violate the above said conditions, this order of bail comes to an end automatically without reference to this Court.
