This order shall dispose of CRM-M-47406-2017, filed by
petitioners-Sailwinder Singh and Sandeep Singh and CRM-M-47637-2017,
filed by petitioner-Jagjit Singh @ Joti, under Section 438 of the Code of

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Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.114 dated 16.06.2017, registered at Police Station Nahianwala, District Bathinda, under Sections 307, 326, 324, 148, 149, 506 and 427 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in both these petitions. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested these petitions.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioners are not named in the FIR. Neither any specific injury nor any role has been attributed to them in the FIR.

In pursuance of the interim orders dated 13.12.2017 passed in CRM-M-47406-2017 and dated 14.12.2017 passed in CRM-M-47637-2017 by this Court, the petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending them to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in these petitions and the same are allowed. The orders dated 13.12.2017 passed in CRM-M-47406-2017 and dated 14.12.2017 passed in CRM-M-47637-2017, granting interim bail to the petitioners, are made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so

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and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
