This petition is for quashing of FIR No. 100, dated 26.09.2013
(**Annexure P-1**) registered under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian
Penal Code ('IPC' - for short) at Police Station Women Cell, Ludhiana, on
the basis of a compromise (**Annexure P-3**) arrived at between the parties

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner, however, submits
