INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners-Gurpreet Singh and Gagandeep Singh have filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.112 dated 17.09.2017, registered at Police Station Chattiwind, District Amritsar Rural, under Sections 307, 324, 323 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent No.1-State and respondent Nos.2 and 3 have also appeared through their counsel. They contested this petition.

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I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, no injury is attributed to petitioner No.1-Gurpreet Singh and simple injury with stick has been attributed to petitioner No.2-Gagandeep Singh. They are not the main accused.

The petitioners have been in custody since 08.10.2017. They are not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as they are in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioners in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail subject to their furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
