The petitioner is seeking a direction to respondent No.2 for a free and fair investigation in FIR No.266 dated 31.10.2017 under Sections 452/323/506/336 IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Chhehrata, District Amritsar, as well as, to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members.

It is stated in the petition that daughter of the petitioner was earlier engaged with respondent No.4. However, due to differences, the engagement was cancelled. Respondent No.4 is stated to be threatening the petitioner and his family members and the afore-noted FIR was lodged in this regard.

Learned counsel has drawn my attention to the representation dated 20.11.2017 (Annexure P-2) sent in this regard and states that the petitioner will be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into his representation dated 20.11.2017 (Annexure P-2).

Consequently, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, to look into the representation dated 20.11.2017 (Annexure P-2) and take action, if necessary, in accordance with law, expeditiously.
