SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J. (ORAL)

 In this petition, the petitioners, who are accused in F.I.R. No. 48, dated 20.04.2014, under Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Payal, District Ludhiana, (Annexure P-1), have prayed for quashing of F.I.R. with all subsequent proceedings pending in the Court of the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Payal, on the basis of compromise.

2. In view of the objection raised on behalf of respondent No. 3, which denotes existence of serious several controversies and which also has the effect of bringing the role of the complainant under a shadow, this Court

is not inclined to allow the compromise at this stage.

3. The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed. The complainant, who appointed respondent No. 3 as her Attorney is, however, at liberty to resort to appropriate proceedings as she thinks fit.
