Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case registered by way of FIR No.37 dated 26.02.2016 at Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 147, 149, 188, 283, 341 IPC and Section 3 of Prevention of Damage to Public Properties Act, 1984 and Section 8-A and 8-B of National Highway Act, 1956.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of orders of interim bail dated 30.01.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Raj Kumar, Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar who submits that the petitioners are no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from them and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

However, keeping in view the stand of the Investigating Officer

and the stand of the State, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 30.01.2017 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.(challan). Thereafter, petitioners will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
