Prayer in this application is for recall of order dated 19.07.2017, whereby the petition was dismissed for non-prosecution and for restoration of the same at its original number.

In view of the arguments addressed and the reasons mentioned in the application, order dated 19.07.2017 is recalled and the petition is restored to its original number.

Application is accordingly allowed.
