This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.9 dated 18.01.2016, under Sections 323, 324, 354, 427, 452, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station, Division Maqsoodan, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the injuries attributed to the petitioners are simple in nature. On 30.08.2016, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kashmir Singh, had informed that the petitioners had joined investigation on 28.07.2016 and one *datar* was recovered from Ranjit Singh-petitioner No.1, whereas one *gandasi* was recovered from Gurpartap Singh-petitioner No.2. Recovery of cars was yet to be effected. It was further informed that co-accused namely Ranjit Singh

29062-2016, which was fixed for 06.10.2016. He was directed to appear before the trial Court and submit his bail/surety bonds. Thereafter, he again joined investigation on 17.02.2017.

Keeping in view that the injuries attributed to the petitioners are simple in nature and the fact that recoveries have already been effected from them, the interim order dated 19.02.2016 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.
