INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Mahender has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.178 dated 21.07.2016, registered at Police Station Baruda, District Sonapat, under Sections 148, 149, 186, 332, 353, 307 and 225 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that absence of the petitioner was not intentional.

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From the record, I find that earlier, the petitioner was on regular bail. However, he absented from the court proceedings on 10.11.2017; his bail was cancelled and warrant of arrest was issued against him.

The petitioner was produced by surety in the Court on 17.11.2017 and since then, he has been in custody. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
