Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.85 dated 01.10.2017 under Sections 326, 452, 324, 323, 427, 34 IPC (the offence punishable under Section 326 IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is a student and as on date he is appearing in the examination. He further states that the injury attributed to the petitioner is an incised wound of 2 cm x .5 cm on the right parietal area of scalp and for this injury, the offence punishable under Section 326 IPC was added at a later stage. There is no other case against the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has filed the affidavit of Sh. Arvinderpal Singh, Deputy Superintendent on behalf of Superintendent Central Jail Gurdaspur, in court today, which is taken on record.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 17.10.2017 and is a student, coupled with the fact that the charges have been framed and the trial in the case may take long time, I deem it appropriate to release him on regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Needless to say that the observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as any expression on the merits of the case.
