Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty and to provide adequate security to protect them from respondent No.4, who is father of petitioner No.2. The petitioners, who are present in Court today, further contend that they being major have solemnized marriage with their own consent in accordance with law. The private respondent is not accepting the marriage of the petitioners and is extending threats to them. Copy of Aadhaar Card of petitioner No.1 (Annexure P-1), copy of driving licence of petitioner No.2 (Annexure P-2) and marriage photographs (Annexure P-3) of the petitioners have been placed on record.

A photocopy of judgment dated 16.10.2017 passed in petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act, has also been placed on record in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Without going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to the petitioners to contact respondent Nos.2 and 3 who, after their satisfaction that the petitioners are

actually facing threat, shall take necessary steps to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from private respondent No.4, as per law.

However, it is made clear that this order, in no way, will affect any other proceedings pending or to be filed against the petitioners etc., which are to be dealt with independently as per law.
