The petitioners have filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.101 dated 07.10.2017, under Sections 307, 323, 325, 506 & 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Behram, District S.B.S. Nagar.

I have perused the FIR carefully. Perusal of the FIR shows that petitioner No.1 is injured by iron rod on the left wrist and petitioner No.2 is injured by iron pipe blow on left ankle.

Upon instructions from the police official, learned counsel for the State submits that there is no other case is pending against the petitioners.

In that view of the matter and fact that the trial will take its

own time, the petitioners be released on bail, subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) The **CRM-M-47694 of 2017** is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioners be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioners to surrender their passport with the trial Court, if they possesses the same.
- (iv) The petitioners would file an undertaking to the trial Court that they will not commit the same or any other kind of offence in future.
- (v) Petitioners shall not tamper, influence and threaten the prosecution witnesses and complainant as well.
- (vi) In case, the petitioners violate the above said conditions, this order of bail comes to an end automatically without reference to this Court.
