The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking benefit of regular bail to the petitioner pending trial in case FIR No. 674 dated 01.10.2014, under Sections 148, 149, 307, 302, 120-B IPC and 25/54/59 Arms Act, registered at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

FIR was registered on the statement of one Neeraj in relation to an alleged occurrence that took place on October 01, 2014 and in which his father Nanhe Ram lost his life and a young infant also suffered pellet injuries.

Complainant-Neeraj as also his uncle Dharam Singh are stated to be the eye witnesses to the occurrence. The present petition is disposed of in terms of the granting liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court afresh after the deposition of the complainant-Neeraj as also

Dharam Singh is concluded.
