This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to arrest respondent Nos.4 to 7 named in FIR No.116 dated 04.10.2016 registered under Sections 302, 323 and 34 IPC at Police Station Bhikhiwind, Tarn Taran (Annexure P-1/T), more than one year has been passed, but the accused persons have not been arrested although they have been found guilty in the inquiry report dated 28.04.2017 (Annexure P-5/T).

Learned counsel for the petitioners restricts his prayer only to early completion of the investigation.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. B.S. Virk, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the FIR No.116 dated 04.10.2016 has been registered under Section 302, 323 and 34 IPC and it has been

argued by the learned counsel for the petitioners that till now, the challan has not been presented and the investigation has not been completed though more than one year has been passed.

In view of above facts, the official respondent are directed to expedite the completion of investigation and presentation of final report.

With aforesaid direction, this petition stands disposed of.
