Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner joined investigation in terms of interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 23.02.2016. The parties were referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of the Court and dispute between the parties has been settled vide settlement/compromise dated 17.11.2016. It is further submitted that in view of compromise between the parties, respondent No.2 has resumed cohabitation with the petitioner and they are leading a happy married life.
