The petitioner is seeking direction to respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect his life and liberty as he has been threatened by respondents No. 5 and 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn my attention to the representation dated 22.11.2017 (Annexure P-2) sent to respondent No. 3 in this regard. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner will be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3 to consider and decide his representation dated 22.11.2017 (Annexure P-2).

Without making any observations on the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala to look into the representation dated 22.11.2017 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner and take action, if necessary, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
