INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Sajjan Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking two days interim bail in case FIR No.13 dated 14.03.2017, registered at Police Station Bhaini Mian Khan, District Gurdaspur, under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code and section 25/27 of the Arms Act, enabling him to attend bhog ceremony being performed on account of '*antim ardass*' of his deceased brother.

Notice of motion was issued in this case.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Learned State counsel has produced on record certificate issued by Station House Officer, Bhaini Mian Khan, confirming the death of brother of the petitioner and Bhog ceremony on 16.12.2017.

In view of the fact that brother of the petitioner namely Bahadur

Singh died on 07.12.2017 and *bhog* ceremony/*antim ardass* is to be performed on 16.12.2017 at native village of the petitioner i.e. Village Phero-Chechi, Police Station Bhaini Mian Khan, District Gurdaspur, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent, Central Jail, Gurdaspur, to produce the petitioner in custody at village Phero-Chechi, Police Station Bhaini Mian Khan, District Gurdaspur, for attending *bhog* ceremony/*antim ardass* on 16.12.2017 from 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM, at the expenses of the petitioner.

Registry is also directed to send a copy of this order to the concerned Jail Superintendent, through fax, for compliance.

As requested, a copy of this order be also supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner under the signatures of Special Secretary of this Court.
