Present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.535 dated 20.10.2017 under Sections 408, 420, 468, 470, 120-B, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner is in custody since 23.10.2017 and the entire recovery, as per prosecution case, has been effected from co-accused Vishal Marwaha, who has already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 18.12.2017 in CRM-M-46984 of 2017; the decision of the case still to take some more time, so the petitioner be released on bail.

Learned State counsel affirmed that fact that the entire recovery has already been effected and the case of the petitioner is on the same footing as that of Vishal Marwaha.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties and the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 23.10.2017; decision of the case still to take some more time; co-accused Vishal Marwaha has already been released on bail in this case and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner in custody, he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of CJM/Area Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
