The instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioner for issuance of a direction to the officials respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to hold investigation in FIR No. 118 dated 13.06.2017 under Section 323, 34, 376 and 452 IPC, registered at Police Station Sanoli (Annexure P-1) and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No. 4 & 5. In this regard she has also approached the authorities by way of representation dated 14.07.2017 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if respondent No.2 be directed to look into the representation dated 14.07.2017 (Annexure P-2), in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr.P.P. Chahar, learned DAG, Haryana who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Three copies of the petition be handed over to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during the course of the day failing which no action is called for. He submits that the

representation dated 14.07.2017 (Annexure P-2) will be decided within a period of four weeks.

Heard.

Without going into the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 14.07.2017 (Annexure P-2), within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order and take necessary action in accordance with law, if required.
