The petitioner is seeking transit anticipatory bail to enable him to appear before the SHO, Police Station Vishwakarma, Jaipur West in response to notice dated 26.11.2017, a copy of which is annexed as Annexure P-1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that allegations against the petitioner are that he was the alleged representative of the company based in America, which had not made the payment to the complainant, although material had been supplied to it. He further contends that the dispute is primarily commercial in nature and the petitioner is willing to settle the same through the company.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of by granting the petitioner interim bail for a period of 15 days from today. Such indulgence is being shown to enable the petitioner to approach the jurisdictional Court in the State of Rajasthan to seek remedy of anticipatory bail.

The petition stands disposed of.
