The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.8 dated 15.01.2010, under Sections 382/34 IPC, registered at Police Station Jandiala Guru, District Amritsar.

Pleadings on record would indicate that the petitioner after arrest had been granted regular bail. He, however, misused the concession and absented from the trial proceedings and accordingly, concession of bail has been cancelled and bail bonds have been forfeited.

Contention raised by counsel is that the petitioner is involved in another FIR bearing No.72 dated 28.07.2015, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kathu Nangal and was in custody and on account of such reason, he had not appeared before the trial Court in proceedings pertaining to FIR No.8 dated 15.01.2010.

During the course of hearing, it has gone uncontroverted that petitioner had been granted bail in FIR No.72/2015 on 17.12.2015. No justification whatsoever is coming forth for the petitioner to have absented

from the trial proceedings in FIR No.8/2010 till 05.10.2016.

Conduct of the petitioner dis-entitles him from the concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition dismissed.
