Through the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. read with Section 340 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks directions to the official respondents to conduct an enquiry and then on the basis thereof, register a criminal case against respondent No.4 for having submitting a false affidavit before this Court.

The petitioner's daughter-Mamta Rani had married respondent No.4 against the wishes of the petitioner. Feeling threat to their life and liberty, daughter of the petitioner and respondent No.4 had filed a joint petition in this Court for seeking protection which was disposed of by this Court on 19.02.2015 with a direction to the concerned Superintendent of Police to look into the matter and provide necessary protection to the petitioners, if their life and liberty is threatened. Alleging that in that petition, respondent No.4 had filed a false affidavit, the petitioner filed the present petition for the afore-referred reliefs.

At the outset, learned counsel for respondent No.4 on instructions from his client submits that from now and in future, respondent No.4 would have no concern with the petitioner's daughter.

In view of the afore-referred statement, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.
