This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R No.137 dated 31.07.2015, under Sections 498-A/506/406/34 IPC (Section 313 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station, City Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

An attempt was made for amicable settlement between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. As per report of the Mediator, the parties could not resolve their disputes.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that the complainant does not want any alimony from the petitioner and ready to withdraw the complaint(s) filed by her against him, so that the petitioner can also withdraw the complant made against her. However, the petitioner, at this stage, is not ready for compromise as he has lost his father during the pendency of this litigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Iqbal Singh, has

informed the Court that in compliance of the order dated 25.02.2016 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation on 03.03.2016 and only 07 tolas of gold is to be recovered from him.

In view of the said fact, the interim order dated 25.02.2016 passed by this Court, is made absolute.

Disposed of accordingly.
