KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in this case, respondent No.4, who is ex.-Principal of S.G.G.S. Khalsa College, Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur has misappropriated the grant of ₹42.30 lacs released by the University Grant Commission (U.G.C.). The S.G.G.S. Khalsa College, Mahilpur, Hoshiarpur wrote a complaint to the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur for lodging the FIR against respondent No.4. Despite complaint dated 18.04.2016 (Annexure P-10) and reminder dated 18.09.2017 (Annexure P-11), no action is being taken.

In the circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction of the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, to dispose of Annexures P-10 and P-11 by passing a speaking order thereon stating whether the police wants to register the FIR or not, and if not, for which reasons. Let necessary orders be passed within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
