M.JEYAPPAUL, J.(ORAL)

Ist respondent-Mehma Singh filed a petition before the trial Court under the Guardians and Wards Act and also under the Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act, praying for custody of his daughter Kumari Sapna from the custody of 2nd and 3rd respondents herein who are the maternal grandparents of the above minor Kumari Sapna. The trial Court granted the relief sought for by the 1st respondent. 2nd and 3rd respondents herein have challenged the custody granted to the 1st respondent in FAO-1843 of 2005. The order passed by this Court on 29.01.2016 in the above FAO by the coordinate Bench of this Court would reflect that the above appeal was disposed of as infructuous on account of the fact that minor Kumari Sapna had attained majority.

The present appeal has been filed by the wife of 1st respondent challenging the custody granted to her husband.

At any rate as it is informed by the counsel appearing on either side that minor Kumari Sapna who was born out of the wedlock on 01.07.1993 has attained majority, the appeal stands disposed of as infructuous.
