Petitioners-Kamlesh and Seema have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.05 dated 03.01.2017, registered at Police Station Sadar Sonapat, District Sonapat, under Sections 148, 149, 323 and 506 IPC and Section 307 IPC, added later on.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioners, who are ladies, have been named in the FIR. They are stated to be armed with *dandas* and have caused simple injuries.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 15.02.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioners have already joined the investigation. They are not required for custodial interrogation. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioners to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 15.02.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
