Petitioner-Navdeep Singh @ Navpreet has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.101 dated 20.10.2017, registered at Police Station Sekhwan, Police District Batala, under Sections 380 and 457 of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, FIR, in the present case, was got registered by the Sub Divisional Officer, P.S.P.C.L. Dehriwal, who stated that computer, C.P.U., monitor and dongal, total valued about ₹25,000/- were stolen in the intervening night of 18-19.10.2017 by breaking the windowpanes from the office of Sub Division

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Adda Dehriwala, Circle area, Electricity Board, Buda Kot. In the FIR, itself, the present petitioner has been named on the basis of suspicion.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the facts that recovery is yet to be effected and the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
