The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.57 dated 30.12.2015, registered under Sections 498-A and 406 of the Indian Penal Code, at Women Police Station, Sector 51, Gurgaon.

Contents that the petitioner has joined the investigation in pursuance of the orders passed by this Court. The challan has also been filed. The mediation proceedings could not materialize on account of marginal differences with regard to the amount for permanent settlement. Now, the petitioner has offered to pay ₹30.00 lakh towards full and final settlement.

Learned counsel for complainant-respondent No.2, on instructions, states that the offer so made is acceptable to her. The

complainant further assures that she shall participate in the proceedings under Section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act and withdraw any other proceedings lodged by her against the petitioner and/or his family members.

Heard.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 26.02.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

However, the same shall be subject to payment of ₹30.00 lakh, to be paid in two equal instalments of ₹15.00 lakh each. The first instalment shall be paid within 45 days from today and the second shall be paid on or before 30th day from the date of payment of first instalment.

The petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
