This petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 293 dated 04.10.2017, under Sections 354, 354-A, 379, 356, 511 and 34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Industrial Area Phase-I, Chandigarh.

At the very outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties and in fact a petition for quashing of the FIR in question has already been preferred in this Court which is registered as CRM-M-39800-2017 and the next date is 19.12.2017. He also submits that co-accused Raj Kumar has also been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 07.12.2017 passed in CRM-M-45816-2017.

Counsel for the respondent-State affirm to the factum of compromise that has been arrived at between the parties for quashing of the FIR in question.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and in view of the fact that the matter stands compromised between the parties, no useful

purpose would be served in keeping the petitioner in custody furthermore.
Hence, the present petition is accepted. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

However, any opinion expressed herein is for the purpose of grant of regular bail and not an opinion on the merits of the case.
