Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members, who are otherwise facing constant threats at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 8.

Record reveals that the petitioner has already got registered an FIR No.115 dated 09.04.2017 under Sections 323 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula against the private respondents No.4 to 8. Similarly, another FIR No.150 dated 02.06.2017 under Sections 171, 420 and 506 IPC has been registered against Ram Diya i.e. husband of the petitioner at Police Station Bhiwani Civil Line, District Bhiwani at the instance of private respondent No.4 Sunil Dutt. Another FIR No.483 dated 15.08.2017 under Sections 379-B, 307, 323 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 has been registered at

Police Station Sadar Bhiwani, District Bhiwani against private respondent No.5 Arvind @ Dhillu and other co-accused at the behest of husband of the petitioner. Further more, an FIR No.651 dated 30.09.2017 under Section 506 read with Section 34 IPC was registered at Police Station City Bhiwani, District Bhiwani against respondents No.4 and 5 and other co-accused on the basis of complaint made by husband of the petitioner.

Thus, in the aforesaid background when a number of cases have been got registered by both the parties against each other, prayer of the petitioner in the present petition is nothing but an attempt to pressurize the accused. As such, no ground of issuance of any such direction is made out and the present petition, being devoid of any merit, is dismissed.
