Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.267 dated 17.12.2016, under Sections 307, 365, 324, 323, 379, 506, 148, 149 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Patiala, District Patiala.

Counsel would advert to the FIR to submit that even as per version of complainant/injured, no specific injury has been attributed to the present petitioner.

That apart counsel would refer to the order dated 31.01.2017 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala at Annexure P-2 to contend that against the alleged occurrence having taken place on 17.12.2016, a compromise has already been entered into with the complainant/injured on 24.01.2017 and during the course of investigation itself.

In view of the above and without making any observations on

merits, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail. Petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the Chief
Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Patiala.
