In this petition, the petitioner seeks his release on regular bail in F.I.R. No.874, dated 07.10.2017, under Sections 384, 386, 388 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Model Town, District Panipat.

2. Custody Certificate of the petitioner is placed on record.
3. The petitioner has remained in detention for more than two months. In the meantime, investigation has already been completed and challan is submitted.
