The petitioner is seeking directions to official respondents No.1 to 3 to conduct free and impartial enquiry into the alleged incident wherein the petitioner is stated to have been beaten up.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has sent a representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh in this regard on 23.11.2017. He further states that he shall be satisfied if the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the representation of the petitioner and take action, in accordance with law.

Issue notice to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. J.S. Toor, Additional P.P., U.T., Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Without making any observation on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to look into the representation of the petitioner dated 23.11.2017 and take action, if necessary, in accordance with law.
